Mr. Wei Yaw Lam, will deliver a presentation on the Security of Payment Act and adjudication, including potential pitfalls in making payment claims and payment responses with reference to recent case law updates.

About the speaker:

Wei Yaw is a Partner in Rajah and Tann LLP's International Arbitration Practice Group. His principal area of practice is commercial dispute resolution, specialising in international arbitration, litigation, adjudication and mediation. In addition, his practice encompasses non-contentious work relating to construction, engineering and infrastructure projects. He is an Accredited Adjudicator with the Singapore Mediation Centre.

Wei Yaw has substantial experience of international arbitration work involving complex and technical disputes relating to major construction, engineering, offshore oil and gas, energy and infrastructure projects in Asia (including in Singapore, Thailand, the Philippines, Hong Kong S.A.R., Vietnam and Laos), in the Middle East (including in Saudi Arabia and Qatar) and in the North Sea, under common law and civil law systems respectively. His experience in conducting arbitrations extends to numerous cases governed by various Rules of Arbitration, including the International Chamber of Commerce (ICC) Rules, the London Court of International Arbitration (LCIA) Rules, the Domestic Arbitration Rules of the Hong Kong International Arbitration Centre (HKIAC), the Singapore International Arbitration Centre (SIAC) Rules, the Singapore Institute of Architects (SIA) Rules and the Thai Arbitration Institute (TAI) Rules. Wei Yaw has also acted in arbitral proceedings before pure ad hoc and UNCITRAL tribunals. In addition, he has conducted judicial proceedings in Singapore, both at trial and at interlocutory hearings (of which several involved issues relating to arbitration).
